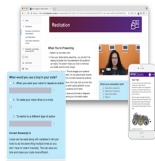

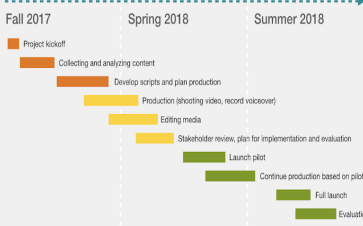
Steps to a Pilot

1. Identify a small, but impactful, segment of content to produce
2. Deliver to students with built-in evaluation measures and/or direct user testing
3. Analyze findings and continue developing content
4. Launch the full package
5. Continue to evaluate against project objectives

Project Schedule for Library Orientation Module



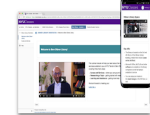
